Food

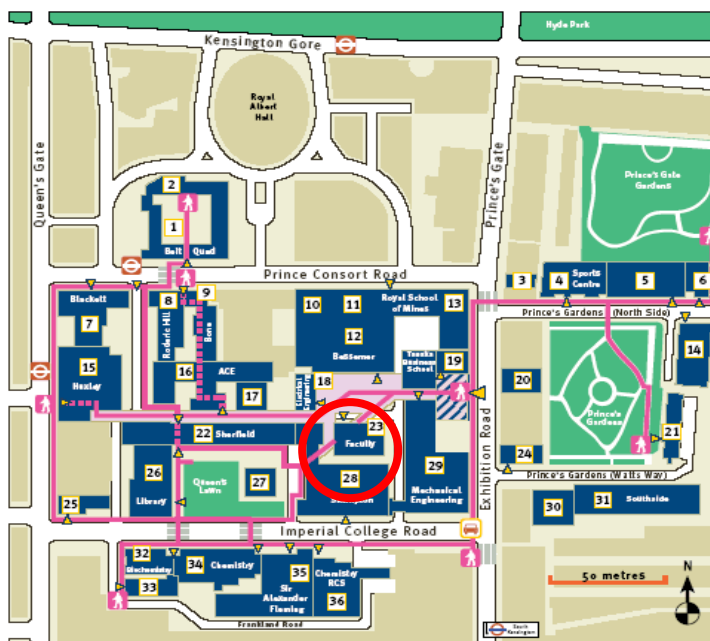



By tube

South Kensington is the nearest tube station. (District, Circle & Piccadilly lines) From within the tube station take the underpass sign posted Museums and exit at the Science Museum. Turn left and then take a short walk up Exhibition Road and you will see the College Main Entrance building on the left. It is a glass fronted building.

By bus
